

Trip to Doñana National Park (Spain), with Birds & Nature

Weekend of 8 th and 9 th May 2010

Leaving Lisbon at 18,00 hours on the evening of the 7 th (Friday) and returning to Lisbon by 17,30 hours on the 9 th (arrival around 23,30 hours)

Doñana is a mythical place for any birdwatcher. This National Park is one of the most important wetlands in the world and Spring is one of the best times of the year for visiting it, with residents and migrants from Africa particularly active, breeding or passing through.

During the tour, we will be visiting the following areas of Doñana: Arroyo de La Rocina, the Acebrón Palace area, the lagoons near El Acebuche Center, the Isla Mayor rice fields, the lagoons and woods near Villamanrique de La Condesa, the Dehesas of Abajo and of Pilas and the areas of Caño Guadiamar and of the José Antonio Valverde Center.

We will be searching for those much sought-after species, some of which are very scarce and difficult to see elsewhere, for example: Little Bittern, Night Heron, Squacco Heron, Glossy Ibis, Marbled Duck, Ferruginous Duck, White-headed Duck, Spanish Imperial Eagle, Red-knobbed Coot, Purple Swamp-hen, Audouin's Gull, Gull-billed Tern, Whiskered Tern and Pin-tailed Sandgrouse.

Price

150 euros per person. Price includes your **Birds & Nature** guide, transport at all times, use of optical equipment, participant's accident insurances and VAT.

Hotel accommodation and meals are paid by the participants.

Accommodation is at the Hotel El Toruño at El Rocío, which price is 36,75 euros per person in a double room or 53,61 euros in a single room, per night.
